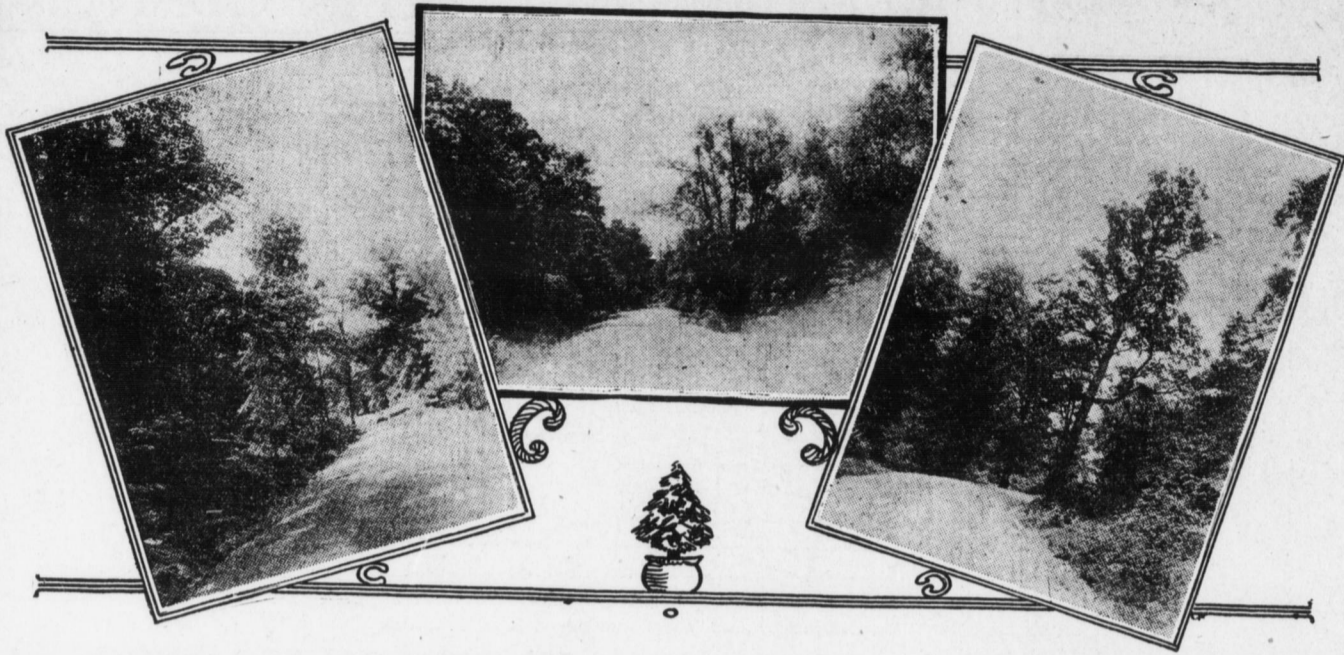

(Continued From First Page) ends of detail remain; these will be straightened out by the Park Board engineers as they complete the final estimate for the contractor.

The Building of the Road is another tale that will always have a place of its own in the history of Harrisburg's public improvements; it's a story of heart-breaking "cuts" of unusual depths through solid limestone, the removal of portions of hills, the eliminating of a section of one of the oldest cemeteries in the world—Potter's Field—the filling in of lowlands and meadows and the draining of swamps.

The section from Cameron street to the almshouse road isn't a new story to the Harrisburg folks; from the old terminus of the Cameron parkway to Derry street and from Derry northward up the valley of the winding Spring creek to the entrance at Reservoir directly east of Cherry Hill is new, however.

Rolling meadow land in the valleys and green wooded slopes; a winding road that is covered with fine crushed stone almost macadam in its consistency for nearly its entire length; and the assurance that only pleasure and no heavier vehicular traffic can use the road combine to make the drive an ideal one.

The new driveway is unique in a number of ways. In the first place it will afford a wonderful "coast" at gentle but attractive grade for automobile or bicycle from the entrance of the road at Reservoir practically the entire distance to Derry street, west of Paxtang—a distance of more than a mile.

The driveway is twenty-two feet wide on the filled ground and twenty-four feet in the "cuts." In some instances side and "hoses" of hills had to be cut back to a distance of fifty feet. In the Dull tract the most serious difficulty with swamp land was overcome by the construction of innumerable "rench" drains.

Four bridges were constructed on the route—one below Derry street and three north of it. Three of the viaducts are constructed of limestone and concrete, made from stone quarried from the "cuts" in the roadway.

A permit was issued to-day to Barney Katzen to build a two-story brick stable in Kunkel avenue in the rear of 565 Herr street. It will cost \$425.

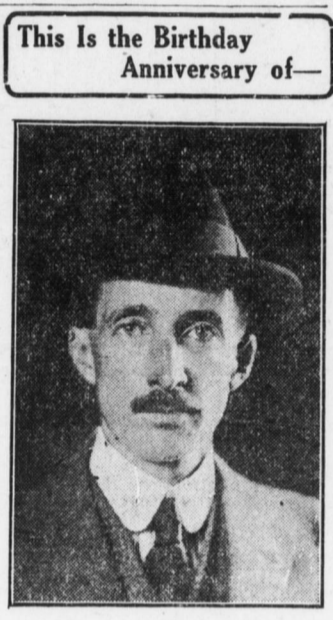

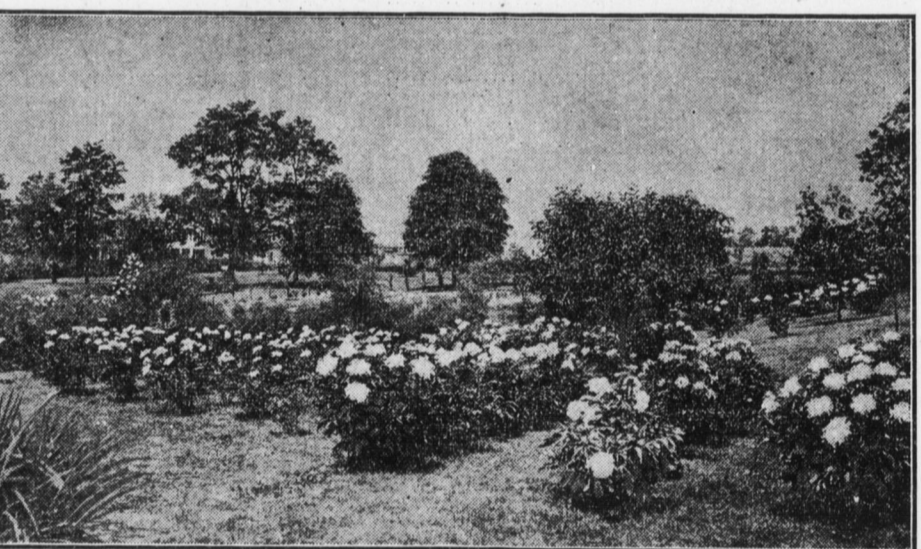

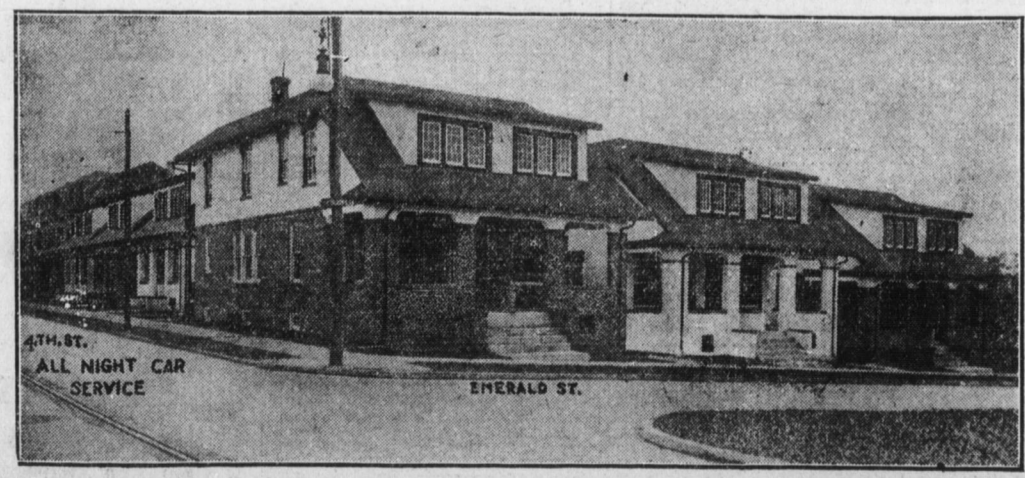
