De Palma Loses Lead When Engine Goes Bad; One Minor Accident

Chicago, June 12.—Dario Resta yesterday won the second annual 300-mile automobile derby at the Speedway here.

De Palma and Resta raced neck and neck throughout the contest, but two laps before the end De Palma developed engine trouble and was forced to go to the pits, losing his lead.

Only one minor accident marred the race. Just before the end of the contest, as Galvin was taking a curve at high speed his car skidded, swung about and rolled into the fence on the inner side of the track.

According to the announcement by the management, almost 100,000 persons saw the race.
