SHORT COVERING CHECKS DECLINE

Crucible and Baldwin First of Specialties to Rise Above Adverse Conditions

New York, July 11.—Buying orders and short covering checked the decline in the first hour, coal products and Alcohol rallying 7 and 5 1/2 points respectively, with material recoveries elsewhere.

Crucible and Baldwin were among the few specialties to rise above adverse speculative conditions, showing moderate gains. Later, rails and United States Steel shaded under increased pressure with declines of 2 1/2 to 5 points in shipping shares. Mexicans also lost ground, Petroleum falling 5 per cent. for call money accompanied the fresh selling before noon. Heavy offerings of Anglo-French \$5 featured the bond market.
