of commercial fertilizers offered for sale in the State and they are now being analyzed to see that they meet with the guarantees of the manufacturers.

The fifteen agents of the Department of Agriculture covered every county of the State in a systematic manner and found fifty-one brands that were not registered as required by the State law. Prosecutions were ordered in all of these cases. The analysis has shown eight samples deficient in the amounts of potash, nitrogen and phosphoric acid guarantee dand prosecutions have been ordered and prosecutions have been ordered against the dealers. The analysis has shown that the manuacturers this year have kept down the guarantee of potash to a very small margin, the shortage of supply, making it almost impossible to obtain potash. The examination of commercial fertilizers is very thorough as the Department of Agriculture aims to protect the consumer from deception and all brands must show the contents as given in the manufacturer's guarantee.

The agents of the Department also collected one hundred and fifty samples of commercial lime and lime products and these are now being analyzed to ascertain that they meet with the standard.
