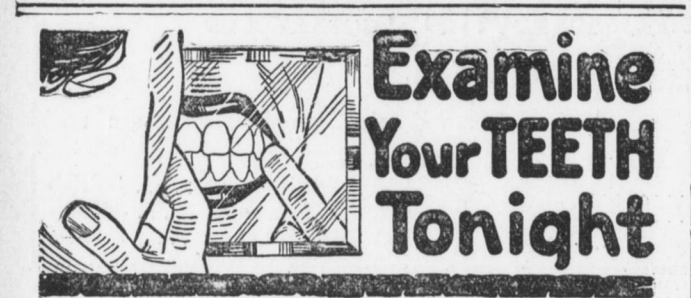

A letter has come to me from two high school girls who are very much puzzled as to the differing viewpoints of their own generation and their fathers.

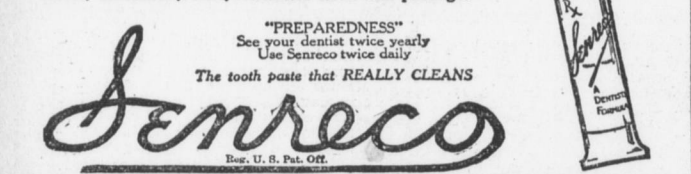
What Father Knows

FOODS THEY BUILD OR DESTROY
AMAZING BUT RARELY SUSPECTED TRUTHS ABOUT THE THINGS YOU EAT

CHAPTER 90
In spite of the application of a hundred and one public health achievements; in spite of extraordinary public health discoveries and disclosures; in spite of the activities of public health officials, many diseases, scarcely known even under primitive conditions of disorder and unsanitary environment, are on the constant increase.

One does not have to go back fifty years to witness the typhoid epidemics that swept over the country, now a cursory glance at the statistics of the actual death rate in New York was approximately 13.4, not 11.56. The cheering figures when analyzed lose their comforting significance.

Skilled physicians and surgeons were not plentiful, nor were the services easily obtained. Puerperal hemorrhage, other accidents of labor, and perperal septicemia were common. It was not so long ago when piles of garbage, filth and decay were to be seen lying in the camps, hamlets, villages, towns and cities of the entire country.

Today every town has its health officer and every city its health department. As much money is spent on health departments in the United States to-day as is spent upon education. In the year 1914 for the city of New York alone \$5,534,240 was appropriated for these current expenses.

When people say that the death rate has dropped from 20 per 1,000 to 11.56 per 1,000 they simply do not know what they are talking about, because no such figures as 20 per 1,000 exist on which to base a comparison, and in the particular instance 11.56, the figures are meaningless, owing to the overzeal on the part of the officials to make a good showing, based on an error involving a difference of 800,000 creatures who do not exist except on paper.

In 1910 the Federal census ascertained that New York city had a population of 4,762,883. In 1915 the State count showed a population of 5,062,222, an actual increase of 300,000. Notwithstanding the official count the health department decrease in the number of city deaths, 5,805,582, an increase of 1,100,000 in five years, whereas in reality there was an increase of only 300,000.
