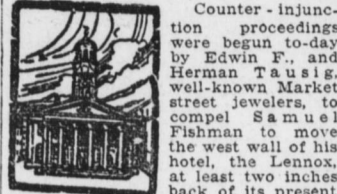

DEPOSITORIES ARE DOWN TO HUNDRED

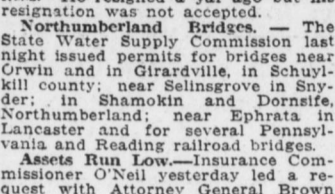
Shortage of Extra Cash Causes Banks to Demand Return of Their Bonds

MAY BIRTHS BOOST THE POPULATION

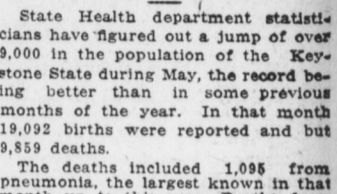
Gain of Over 9,000 Reported to the State Department of Health's Office
