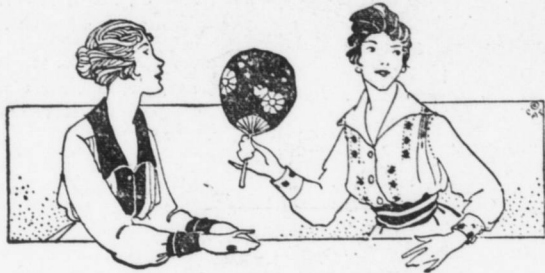

#### DANIELS WELCOMES CIVILIANS

Washington, Aug. 15.—Messages from Secretary Daniels welcoming more than 2,000 civilians participating in the naval training cruise for national defense were published to-day upon the ships. The messages were as follows:

"Upon the embarking of more than 2,000 civilians who are to take part in the civilian cruise, I wish to convey to them the congratulations of the Navy Department that we can wel-

come them as the newest recruits of the first arm of the national defense. I am sure under the instruction which officers will give them their cruise will be of great benefit to them and their country."

#### CONFERS WITH COMMITTEE

Washington, Aug. 15.—President Wilson to-day conferred with the Democratic Campaign committee at luncheon. He will see the associate committee of Progressives later.

#### Colonel Jos. H. Horton, Civil War Hero, Is Dead

Towanda, Aug. 15.—Joseph H. Horton, lieutenant colonel of the 141st regiment, Pennsylvania volunteers, who won fame for himself on many battlefields, died last night. Colonel Horton was a native of this county, the son of wealthy parents and coaxed his father to allow him to enter the army, finally gaining con-

sent. At the battle of Gettysburg, Horton, then a captain, was the only captain left of the 141st when the fighting ended.

#### LAKE STEAMERS COLLIDE

Detroit, Mich., Aug. 15.—The Topeka, a small coal boat, was rammed by the steamer Christopher in the Detroit river off Sandwich, Ont., early to-day. The Topeka sank in forty feet of water after her crew had

been rescued. The Topeka, of 1,376 gross tons, was built in 1889 and is owned by the Lake Shore Steamship company, of Milwaukee. The Christopher is the property of D. Sullivan and company, of Chicago.

#### OIL TAKES ANOTHER DROP

Pittsburgh, Pa., Aug. 15.—Further reduction in the price of the principal grades of crude oil was announced to-day at the opening of the market,

all grades being cut five cents a barrel except ragland which remained at 75 cents. The new prices are Pennsylvania crude \$2.30; cabal, \$1.82; corning, Mercer black and New Castle, \$1.80; Somerset, \$1.65. This is the fourth cut within a month.

#### HAS 1200 HORSES ABOARD

Philadelphia, Pa., Aug. 15.—Carrying a cargo of 1,200 of the best horses that the Western section of this coun-

try could furnish, the British steamship Georgic left this port to-day. She cleared for Brest, France, and carries a four-inch gun aft that for a time worried the authorities, though it was admittedly for defense only. The horses, which will be used in the allied armies, cost \$300 each, and besides this cargo, the Georgic carried flour, wheat and corn for Liverpool. Sixty attendants and one veterinary surgeon accompanied the horses.
