

"LIAR" IS USED IN SENATE DEBATE

Ashurst Angered by "Copper Lobby" Remark Names Penrose

Washington, Sept. 7.—Charges and counter charges flew across the main aisle of the Senate...

Senator Smoot, Republican, of Utah, who occupied a chair between the two speakers, went through mock hysterics, saying, "Don't, don't!" as though he feared a tragedy was about to be enacted.

Later he was quite as serious, although rigidly polite, when he said that "if" Senator Penrose asserted a certain thing he had used the word "liar." Great emphasis was placed on the little word "if" and finally the language was withdrawn.

"Sweetbreads for Brains" "If the Senator charges that this is violation of the law," said Ashurst, when he got the floor, "he has sweetbreads for brains."

Passes the "Lie Indirect" A little later Ashurst turned on Penrose, who said he had noticed a "copper lobby" around the capital...

Several senators objected to this language, and Ashurst, after explaining he had said "if," agreed to withdraw his remarks.
