New York, Oct. 5.—The rising cost of food was impressed upon thousands of citizens yesterday by the action of one of the largest dairy restaurants here in advancing prices. This corporation, which owns a chain of lunch rooms in New York and other cities, added five cents to the prices of all the staple dishes.

Bacon and eggs and ham and eggs now cost thirty cents instead of twenty-five; a small steak is thirty cents instead of twenty-five; plain omelette has jumped from fifteen cents to twenty cents. Even corned beef hash has advanced from fifteen cents to twenty-tanced from fifteen cents to twenty. Eggs are five cents an order higher, no matter how prepared.
