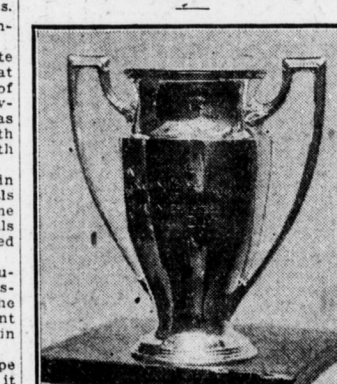

The bureau of animal industry, United States Department of Agriculture, was represented by Dr. Robert M. Mullins, who carefully examined the evidence of those irregularities which the board of health placed before him.

Every reputable physician with a conscience will say the same thing. 'The Board of Health of the State of New Jersey does not know what becomes of all the tubercular cows of that state and has no means of knowing. The legislature at Trenton has blocked every important public health question which the board of health has ever put before it.'

At the present time I see no hope for the situation. Certified milk, as it is only too frequently produced, is a farce. The people themselves are to blame. The whole State is steeped in lethargy and indifference to all questions concerning public health and it will continue to pay the price in disease and death until somebody succeeds in arousing its intelligence and its conscience.'
