QUALITY THE MOST ESSENTIAL THING IN LIVESTOCK Farm and Fireside, the national farm paper, says about livestock: 'Quality becomes more essential to profit in livestock farming each season. When labor, land, and feed were cheap it was possible to realize a profit on livestock of an inferior grade, but with the present high cost of these production factors and a constant discrimination on the market against the scrub, it has become evident that the greatest profit can be expected only from livestock of good quality. It may be possible for the feeder or dealer to make a profit on inferior livestock if he is able to buy it sufficiently cheap and sell quickly, but usually someone has not realized the greatest possible profit when a scrub goes to market. If it is not the feeder, it is the man who produced the animal.'
