FIRE BURNS CATHOLIC CHURCH

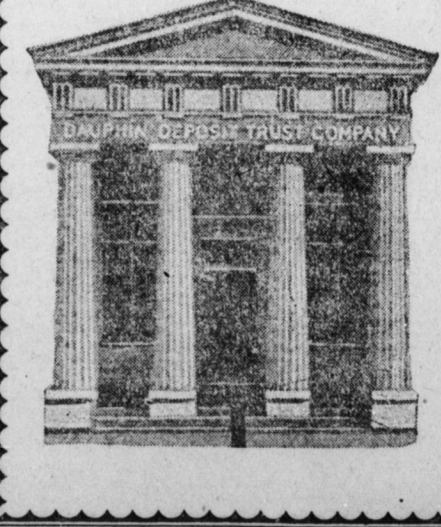
Quebec, Nov. 24. -- Fire to-day destroyed the Limolou Roman Catholic Church here with a property loss estimated at \$180,000.
