HOW TO BAKE AND SAVE EGGS. Mrs. Wood Gives Some Toothsome Ideas to City's Housewives

[By Mrs. Anna Hamilton Wood] In the words of the Apostle, "Rejoice!" The latest advice to us that flour has dropped a dollar a barrel in Chicago. It sounds encouraging with Christmas on the way and so much baking to be done.

Put into a kettle 1 cupful dark brown sugar, 1 1/2 cups water, 1 1/2 cups seedless raisins, 1-3 cup lard, 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon, 3/4 teaspoon ground cloves, 1/4 teaspoon grated nutmeg, 1/4 teaspoon salt.

Let boil about three minutes and set aside. When fairly cool add 2 scant cups flour in which one-half teaspoon Royal baking powder and one teaspoon of soda had been mixed. Add one cup of chopped and floured nut meats and bake in moderate oven.
