

LEAK STORY BY BROTHER-IN-LAW OF WILSON SAYS

R. W. Bolling Thinks Representative Wood Should Send Him Apology, Too

"READ IT IN PAPERS"

After Short Session, Hearing Adjourns; Investigation Unlikely

Washington, Jan. 10. — After another brief session to-day the House Rules Committee suspended public hearings on Representative Wood's resolution to investigate whether there was a stock market leak on President Wilson's peace note.

No formal action was taken by the committee in its executive session. Members stated, however, that the Wood resolution probably would be adversely reported to the House.

Whether to recommend specific investigation of Law's general charges of Stock Exchange operations by government officials or a broad inquiry into the Stock Exchange, is the question now being considered.

With a view to determining the source of the information which caused Dow Jones and Company to carry a rumor on its ticker on December 20 that a peace note was coming, the House Rules Committee has subpoenaed C. W. Barron, head of the ticker service, it was announced to-day.

R. W. Bolling, a brother-in-law of President Wilson and a member of F. A. Connolly and Company, brokers, Washington, was the first witness at to-day's hearing. He denied he had anything to do with a "leak."

"I have nothing to say," he said, "except that whoever is responsible for bringing my name into this, Representative Wood, I believe, might send me an apology at the same time that he sends one to Secretary Tumulty."

"When did you receive your first information regarding the President's note?" Representative Henry asked.

"When I read it in the newspaper," he said. "I never receive from any source," Representative Garret asked, "any intimation of the President's so-called peace note in advance of its publication?"

"Absolutely not," he said. "Any other member of your firm received such information?"

"Absolutely no member had any advance information," he said. Bolling said he had no knowledge of any official of the government or administration who had profited by stock transactions as a result of the peace note, and was excused after a brief examination.

Kelsey Again to Help Plan Color Scheme For "Black-and-White" Ball

TO PRESERVE LINCOLN PEW

Gettysburg, Pa., Jan. 10.—Workmen have started tearing out the pews in the historic Presbyterian church here, in which Abraham Lincoln worshipped on November 19, 1863. However, the pew occupied by the martyred President, which now bears a bronze plate, will not be disturbed, while the renovation of the interior is in progress. Bloodstains under the several layers of varnish on the pews will be removed and the last traces of the hospital which was established in the church during the battle. The church is nearly 175 years old.

THE WEATHER

River Stage: 6.4 feet above low-water mark.

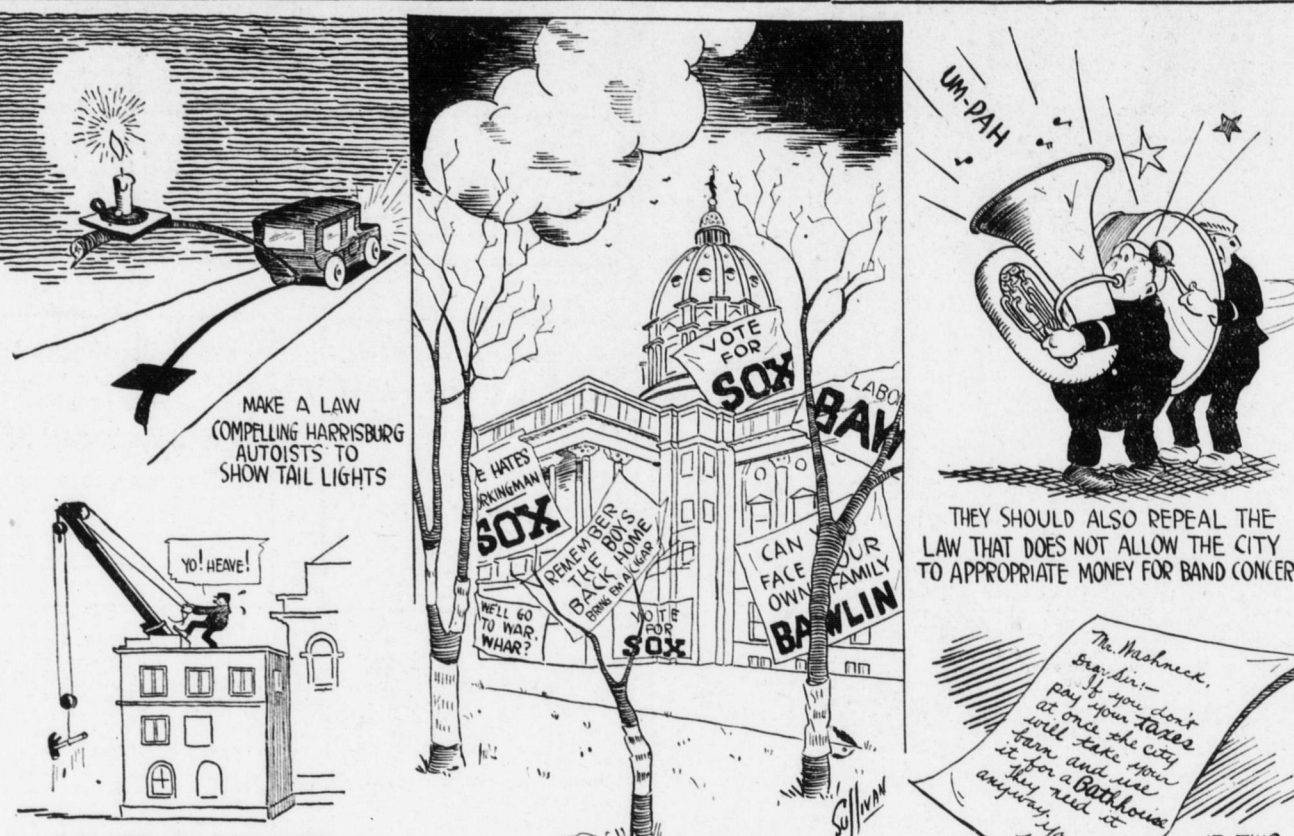
