

mine the selection in future of chief executives of important industrial corporations, John D. Rockefeller, Jr., predicted to-day in an address at Cornell University on the occasion of founder's day.

Mr. Rockefeller said the time is rapidly approaching when this change will occur and he believed the "personal relation in industry" would eventually. be regarded as an important part of college courses which aim to fit men for business life.

"It is regrettably true," he asserted, "that there are capitalists who regard labor as their legitimate prey, from whom they are justified in getting all they can for as little as may be. \$t is also true that on the part of labor there has been a growing feeling that it was justified in wresting everything possible from capital. So these two great forces have come too often to think that their interests are antagon listic and have worked against each other, each alone seeking to promote its own selfish ends.

"If in the days to come," he told the students, "as you have to do with labor, you will put yourself in the other man's place and govern your action by what you would wish done to you were you the employe instead of the employer, the problem of the establishment of the personal delation in industry will be solved."
