WOMEN ORGANIZE FOR DEFENSE
Guarantee That They Will Look After Their Own Safety; Up to Men

A new league has been organized by American women. It is called The American Woman's League for Self-Defense. Its motto is: American Women First.
Its object is to educate our women to the highest standard of HEALTH, PURITY, EFFICIENCY, PROFICIENCY, SELF-RELIANCE. TO TAKE THE PLACE OF HUSBANDS AND FATHERS WHEN NECESSITY REQUIRES IT. Its platform is NON-POLITICAL, NON-RACIAL, NON-COLOR AND NON-CREED.
Its founders are Miss Ida Elsworth

Lowber and Mrs. E. Vandercook-Browne, its adviser is Mrs. Lee G. Boardman and its secretary Miss Ida Vera Simonton.
Here is what one of its members has to say of the league, speaking of what war has taught woman:
"It proves primarily that women must depend largely upon themselves for adequate protection. It shows conclusively that governments, especially in cases of invasion, are powerless to protect their women while their fighting men are at the front."
"It demonstrates that the women themselves are no match for the unhealthy local rabble that—unable to plunder and pillage when opportunity offers. It is a well known fact that weeks of prolonged hardships foster a mental recklessness that destroys all decent sense of consideration and abnormalism precludes the better-minded in an invading army from shielding women from its own rampant self."
Women Cannot Rely Upon Man to Save Her in Time of War.
"Clearly woman cannot rely upon man to save her in war time; she must find her defense, as she finds

her danger, solely within herself. This emphasizes the necessity for the 'weaker sex' becoming, not the 'stronger,' but a 'strong sex.' Surely, if it comes to finalities, a quick, clean, honorable death from a well-aimed bullet is preferable to the lingering horror which comes of considering one's self innately helpless."
"THIS ORGANIZATION POSITIVELY IS NOT FOR AGGRESSION, BUT FOR PROTECTION. IT IS FOR REPULSION IN CASE OF ATTACK. We wish to enlist all the women of America who are physically and mentally sound. We intend to create regiments of trained, efficient soldier-girls for self-defense in case of need—powerful, resourceful bodies of women, able not only to protect themselves, but those of their sex who for various reasons are unable to do so."
"THIS LEAGUE IS A GUARANTEE TO THE MEN OF THE UNITED STATES THAT IF THEY WILL ENDEAVOR TO THEIR UTMOST ABILITY TO PROTECT OUR PROPERTIES, OUR HOMES AND OUR BELOVED COUNTRY FROM OPPRESSION AND TREACHERY, WE WILL

ASSURE THEM THAT WE CAN PROTECT OURSELVES."
"We desire to put this proposition fully before the public in order that the drilling may begin at once, as every moment is of value. We urge the largest possible enlistment, because in this training we feel that we are not thrusting a burden on our sisters, but are conferring a pronounced benefit."
"These preliminary callisthenics will be followed by exercises and drills in the same order as those given to the male soldier. After these you will be instructed in indoor bayonet drill, rifle and pistol target practice. You will learn how to point and aim, how to fire, clean and reload a rifle."
"Fair weather will see practice marches and women's military camps, with all their active routine, including range and field firing. You will learn gradually of sights and wind gauges and their adjustments. You will be initiated into all the mysterious and fascinating military detail which, when mastered, spells a sure self-defense. You will become eventually a self-reliant, splendidly developed, courageous

soldier girl, well able to take care of yourself and a dozen others."
Large Department of Don'ts Ready for Use in Silencing Mrs. Grundy.
"To silence Mrs. Grundy and keep her busy we shall give her a large department of Don'ts. Chief among them will be the admonition, 'Don't talk too much. Don't be militant; be military. Don't be aggressive; be conciliatory. Don't lose your head; others may go with it. Don't shirk work, and a hundred other 'to be's' and 'not to be's.' Hers will be the task of keeping well persons well and with her dampening caution calming excitable and quelling panics."
