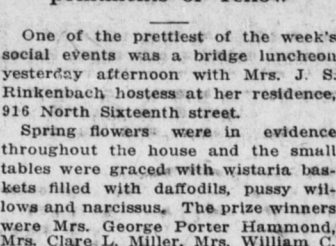
MRS. RINKENBACH HAS CARD PARTY
