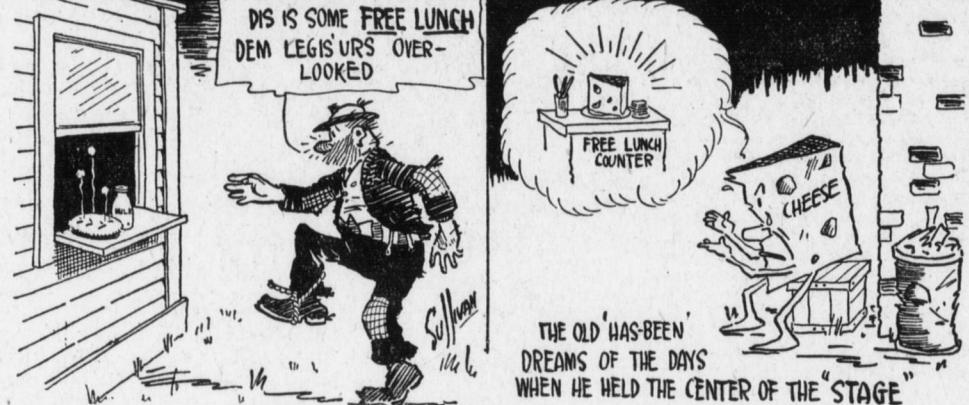

RED CROSS SEALS RAISE A MILLION

Three Hundred Million Penny Holiday Tokens Sold in 1916 Christmas Campaign

New York, March 6.—Red Cross seal Christmas seals raised in the 1916 \$1,000,000 for the tuberculosis campaign, according to the National Association for the Study and Prevention of Tuberculosis, which announced to-day the results of the recent holiday campaign.

All the proceeds of the sale, amounting to a tax for health work of one cent on each person in the country except the insular possessions, are devoted to preventive tuberculosis work in the States and communities in which the seals are sold.

The National Association points with gratification to the fact that it realized its slogan "one seal for each inhabitant in the United States." Seals have been sold annually at the holiday season, beginning with 1908.
