PNEUMONIA CAN BE AVOIDED NOW

Dr. Dixon Gives Some Pointers on How to Stay Well in the Springtime

Pneumonia can be avoided if people will take the trouble to govern their diet and habits and not to indulge in excesses says Dr. Samuel G. Dixon, Commissioner of Health. The commissioner in a statement issued yesterday calls attention to the dangers. He says:

There is a great variety of lung congestions called pneumonias sometimes preceding the true infectious pneumonia which are caused by microscopic organisms or germs.
