

TWO NEW ISSUES CENTERS OF TRADE

Sinclair Oil and Midvale Steel Attract Many Buyers With Market's Opening; Bethlehem Steel Scores Further Advance

New York, March 29.—Wall Street—Much of today's early trading centered around two new issues, Sinclair Oil and Midvale Steel. The former on very heavy dealings soon scored an extreme advance of five points to 6 3/4, but Midvale made little headway, ranging between 38 and 39 1/4 against yesterday's final price of 36 3/4 on the curb. Recent active specialties, notably Driggs-Seabury and Wilson Packings, were again prominent in gainings of 1 1/2 to 2 1/2 points.

Bethlehem Steel new stock, Lackawanna Steel, American Can, Texas Company and Hide and Leather common and preferred rose 1/2 points. U. S. Steel and Standard rails were irregular. Special stocks increased their gains for the most part, Wilson Packing rising six points with 2 1/2 for American and Continental Cans. Ohio Gas rose 3 1/2 points with as much for Montana Power. In the steel group, Virginia Iron rose 4 points and oils were featured by gains of 2 to 3 points in Texas Company and Mexican Petroleum, although Sinclair reacted.

A special demand for the secondary stock issues set in at midday, those stocks rising 1 to 2 points. Rails, metals and shippings were comparatively neglected. Bonds were steady.

Philadelphia, March 29.—Women connected with the Red Cross of New Jersey have been caught placing poison in hospital bandages intended for use in army and navy hospitals, according to Albert W. Staub, director of the Atlantic Division of the American Red Cross.
