Two More National Guard Batteries Are Called Out

Washington, D. C., March 30.—Batteries E and F of the Tenth Field Artillery, Connecticut National Guard, were called into federal service to-day by War Department orders. No explanation of the call was made by the department, but they probably will be used for police protection purposes. Orders were being prepared to-day for calling out of additional guard forces in several eastern states. They contemplate an increase of at least two regiments of infantry to the 50,000 guardsmen already added to the federal service for police protection work.

HUNDREDS OF REQUESTS FOR BOOKS CONTAINING MILITARY INFORMATION

The HARRISBURG TELEGRAPH has received numerous requests from readers desirous of obtaining information as to the sources of military education for those who will answer the call to arms when it comes. The sources are infinite, but the following list will provide a selection from which the student may obtain those which apply particularly to the branch of service in which he is interested.

The Harrisburg Public Library and the State Library are in a state of preparedness for the onslaught of militarily inclined readers, and Miss Eaton, of the Public Library, has also on hand all the pamphlets and literature obtainable at the local recruiting stations for the Army and Navy.

These books may be taken out at the State Library:
Infantry Drill Regulations, United States Army Field Regulations, Manual of Military Training, by Captain James A. Moss, Studies in Minor Tactics, 1915, published by the Army Service School at Fort Leavenworth.

Andrews, United States Army Regulations, 1916, Army Infantry Tactics, Also a large collection of books on coast artillery, cavalry, military engineering, signal corps, and other branches.
