

STOCKS FEEL EFFECT OF STEADY PRESSURE

Leading Issues of Steel, Munitions, Equipment, Shipping and Metals Show Recession of Several Points; Rails Also Down

New York, March 31.—Stocks were under steady pressure during today's brief trading period, leaders including United States Steel, munitions, equipments, shipments and metals showing extreme recession of 1 to 2 points with 2 points for some of the prominent rails. Dealings were unusually circumscribed, steel, copper, marines and oils contributing considerably over half of the total turnover.

The new features of actual strength again included such special issues as Ohio Gas, Wilson, Becking and Virginia Iron at gross advances of 1 1/2 to almost 5 points. Final prices were at or near lowest levels. The closing was heavy. Sales approximated 300,000 shares.
