

### COUPLE WED ON MARYLAND LINE

#### Pennsylvania Veteran of Civil War Marries Widow of Southern Soldier

Waynesboro, Pa., April 4. — There was much of the romantic in the marriage yesterday evening of a Civil War veteran, V. Otto Coombs, and Mrs. Mary E. Pryor, widow of a Civil War veteran. They went to the Mason-Dixon line, near Ringgold, Md., and standing on the Maryland side of the line, under the great oaks near the Menonite Church on the State Road, they were married by the Rev. Dr. George F. Boggs, pastor of the Methodist Church of Waynesboro, at 7.30 o'clock, the illumination being furnished by the headlights of automobiles. The trip to the romantic wedding place was made in automobiles. Four

people went from Waynesboro and five came from Smithsburg, Md. The ceremony was witnessed by Mr. and Mrs. John Seighman, Mr. and Mrs. G. E. Ridenour and Mrs. John Brown, Smithsburg, and H. G. Feltz, of Waynesboro. After the ceremony the witnesses came to Waynesboro with the bride party. Mr. Seighman presented the bride with a large bridal cake.

This is Mr. Coombs' third matrimonial venture and Mrs. Coombs' second. The marriage followed a courtship of three months. The bride, who is 64 years old, is the widow of George W. Pryor, who was a member of Company, K, First Maryland Cavalry, Potomac Home brigade. She lived at Smithsburg the greater part of her life, coming to Waynesboro recently.

Mr. Coombs, who is 75 years of age, is a veteran of the Civil War, having served in Battery E, First Pennsylvania Light Artillery. He enlisted at York. For a number of years he lived at Baltimore, coming to Waynesboro in 1910. He is a past post commander of Captain John E. Walker Post, No. 287, G. A. R., and for three years has been its adjutant.
