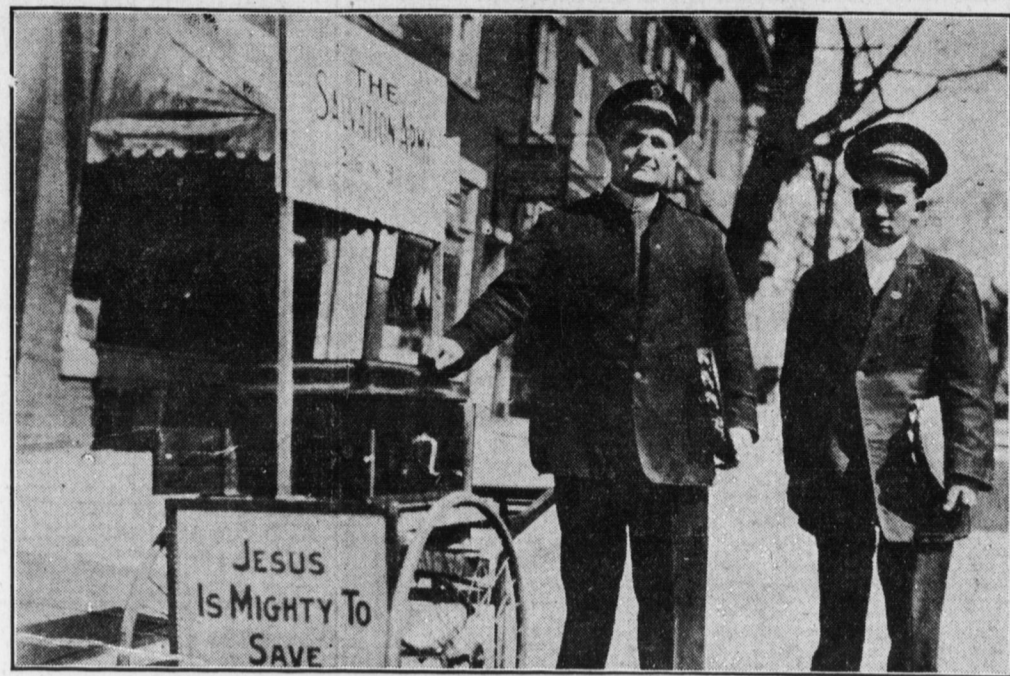
Jubilee Conference at Grace Church Tuesday
