

MARKET PRICES DROP IN SELLING MOVEMENT

Discouraging Attitude Adopted in Official Quarters Respecting Foreign Conditions Hurts Stock Issues: Offerings Are Relatively Moderate

New York, May 3. (Wall Street) — Stocks were in process of further liquidation at today's opening, selling orders accumulating over night as a result of the more discouraging attitude adopted in official quarters respecting foreign conditions. Equipments and munitions dropped 1 to 3 points, this also applying to ship prices, copper and the many specialties commonly associated with the various war groups.
