General Improvement in Prices Follows Moderate Declines in Early Trading; Munitions Equipments and Shippings Average a Point Under Yesterday's Closing

New York, May 15 (Wall Street).—The international situation more particularly the news from Russia, was again the cause of moderate unsettlement at the outset of today's market operations. Leading munitions equipments, copper and shippings averaged a point under closing prices of the preceding session. United States Steel, whose initial offering comprised 600 shares at 117 to 116 1/2, showed a maximum decline of half a point. High-grade like Union Pacific, Reading and Great Northern, were affected to a similar extent and Ohio Gas lost 2 1/2 points. Mexican Petroleum was the noteworthy exception, advancing 1/2 to 3 points. General improvement set before the end of the first half hour.
