Making Sauce or Puree

Washington, D. C., July 30.—Since tomatoes contain a very high percentage of water, it often is desirable to can only concentrated tomato products. This is true especially when cans or jars are difficult to obtain. A delicious concentrated tomato sauce may be made and canned as follows, says the United States Department of Agriculture. Small or broken tomatoes and large tomatoes unsuitable for canning whole, may be used in this receipt.

Cut the tomatoes into fairly small pieces and add one large-sized onion chopped and one cup chopped sweet red pepper to one gallon tomatoes. Cook until tender. Put through a sieve and add a mixture of one-third salt and two-thirds sugar in a proportion of one teaspoonful to each quart of the mixture. Cook until the consistency of ketchup, stirring constantly. Pack hot into sterilized jars or bottles. Adjust rubber and cap—place the containers on a false bottom in a vessel of water sufficiently deep to reach almost to their tops and allow to remain at a boiling temperature for twenty-five minutes. Remove jars from the water bath and tighten the lids immediately.
