PINK POSTCARDS TO ORDER DRAFTED MEN TO MOBILIZE

Pink postcards, giving instructions for mobilization to the men selected for the first quota of the new National Army, have been received by the local district draft boards.

Form No. 164 C. By direction of the Secretary of War, you are hereby ordered to report to the office of this Local Board at ... on the ... day of ... 1917.

From the date herein specified for you to report, you will be in the military service of the United States and subject to military law.

You will be held under the orders of this board until the hour of departure of your train.

Since you will not be permitted to retain any trunks after your arrival at the railroad station, the articles listed above should be brought in a hand bundle.

If you desire to do so, you may return the civilian clothes you are wearing when you arrive at the mobilization camp to your home by express or otherwise.
