PRINT PAPER

Washington.—A nation-wide survey of the newsprint paper situation was begun to-day by the Federal Trade Commission. Commissioner Colver and Dr. E. O. Merchant, who conducted the commission's news and bookprint paper investigation earlier this year, will have charge. Letters to print paper manufacturers saking for co-operation have been sent out. Manufacturers will be required to submit complete weekly and monthly reports. The first weekly report must be mailed on or before September 25. Canadian manufacturers will co-operate with the Federal Trade Commission.
