BOLOPASHA HAD OPEN ENTRY TO AMERICAN BANKS

Gigantic Financial Plot Directed by German Foreign Office

New York, Oct. 5. — The full details of the sensational conspiracy whereby Paul Bolo Pasha, under arrest in Paris, as a spy, obtained the transfer through well known and unsuspecting banking houses in New York of a German peace propaganda fund of \$1,700,000 to France, will be delivered to the French embassy today by Attorney General Meriton E. Lewis, of New York state.

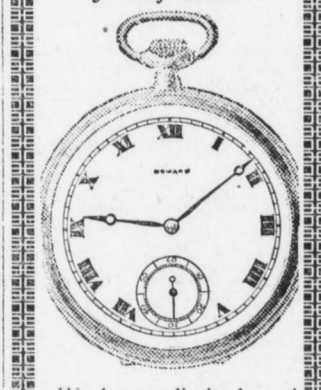
