Zurich, Switzerland, Oct. 23.—Friedrichshafen is in mourning over the loss of at least four Zeppelins in the ill-fated raid on England, according to advices received here from Swiss towns on Lake Constance.

Thirteen in Raid Paris, Oct. 22.—Official examination of the crews of the Zeppelins captured in France on returning from the raid shows that the expedition consisted of thirteen airships which left singly from three depots on the night of October 19.

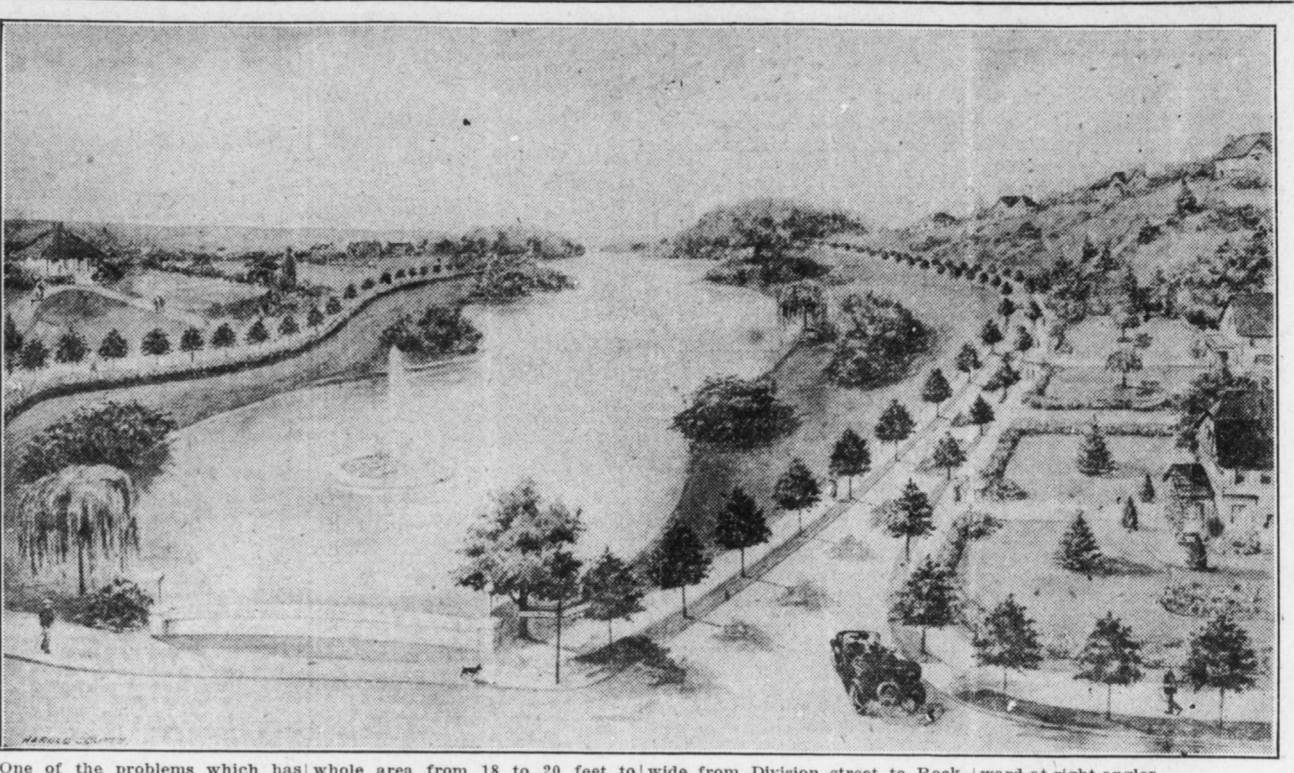
