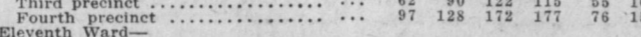

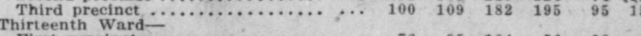

Anti-Prohibition Forces Lead in Cincinnati

Cincinnati, Nov. 7.—With only 429 precincts to hear from, the anti-prohibition forces maintained a lead of 3,753 at noon to-day on detailed figures reported from all the counties in Ohio except one.

Harrison county sent an estimate that the county would go dry by 2,500 votes, but this estimate was not included in the precinct figures which gave from 5,327 precincts out of 5,753 in Ohio for prohibition, 47,581; against, 478,334.

President Will Take Action to Control Price and Fix Size of Loaf

Washington, Nov. 7.—Direct action to control the price of bread and fix the size of a standard loaf will be taken soon by President Wilson in a proclamation placing all bakers under the license system administered by Food Administrator Hoover.
