Steels and affiliated shares eased later on very light offerings. Liberty Bonds were inclined to improve.

A few rails and industrials strengthened on the nominal dealings of the morning but the heaviness of specialties and bonds acted as a further drag. New minimums included Tobacco. American Telephone and several of the foreign war flotations, that list embracing Anglo-French 5's French government 5'½'s declining from 98.54 to the new low of 98.40, the 4's ranging at 98.18 to 97.
