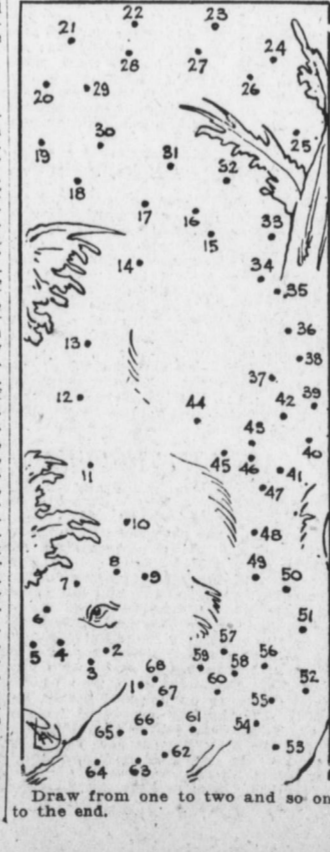
DEAR MISS FAIRFAX:

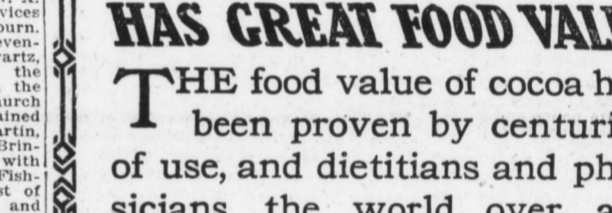
