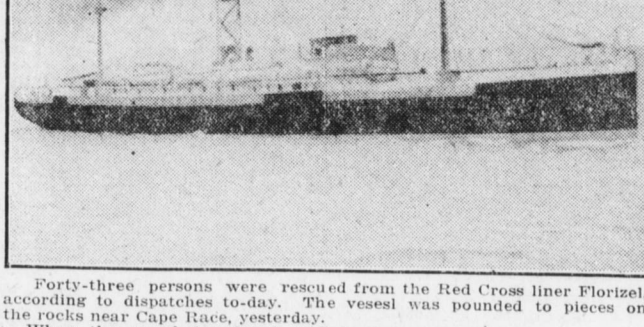

German Revolution Is Predicted in Reichstag; New Strike Campaign

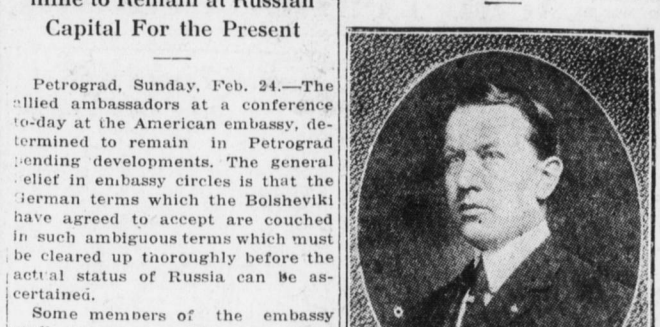
