Are Bombed by British Are Bombed by British.

London, March 11. — British aviators bombed the Daimler Motor Works at Stuttgart yesterday. The official announcement says:

On March 10 Germany was again bombed by our planes in broad daylight. On this occasion the Daimler Motor Works at Stuttgart were attacked. More than one and a quarter tons of bombs were dropped. Several bursts were observed on the railway station where a stationary train was hit and seen to be on fire.

Three burts were observed on a munition factory southeast of the town, and other bursts on the Daimler works and buildings around.

Hostlie machines made a weak attempt to attack our formation over an objective, but withdrew on being attacked. All of our machines returned except one, which had engine trouble and went down under control just before recrossing our lines on the homeward journey.
