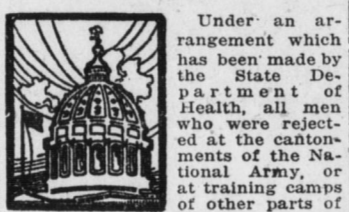

STATE EXTENDS MEDICAL HELP

Would Have Drafted Men Given Advice in Regard to Certain Diseases



Under an arrangement which has been made by the State Department of Health, all men who were rejected at the cantonments of the National Army, or at training camps of other parts of the military service, because of incipient tuberculous conditions, are being looked up and offered the medical advice of the state authorities.

Sometime ago State Health Department officials began looking up the reasons for rejections of men at camps after having been passed by local boards. In some districts the reports showed tuberculous conditions and requests have been made at Washington for data on the subject.

Five New Camps

Five camps for the planting of trees on state forest lands are to be established this spring by the State Forestry Department. The department some time ago issued a call for men to work in the woodlands on the extensive reforestation projects for which the commonwealth has been raising trees for several years.

To Protect Deer

U. S. ARMY CAMP AT GETTYSBURG

Regiment of Engineers Expected to Arrive at Famous Battlefield in Short Time

Gettysburg, Pa., March 11.—All the rumors that have been widespread over the town for the last month or more have been silenced by the announcement to-day that the United States Army camp will soon be opened for the summer.

The engineer regiment is expected here in a week or two and the men will be housed in the mess halls until their tents arrive, although some are of the opinion that barracks will be built for this outfit, which will likely number between four and five thousand men.

The outfit soon to arrive is a tank engineer regiment and when fully equipped will have sixteen of the big battle tanks which have proved so successful for the allies on the western front.
