

HUNS DISMAYED AS DRIVE FAILS TO GAIN GROUND

Army Staff, Through Press, Preparing Public For Shock
Washington, April 9.—A digest of German opinion on the situation in Picardy, given in an official dispatch from France, says the German general staff is instructing the military correspondents to reassure the public and with over-emphasized explanations is betraying the dismay of the public at the prospect of a check of the great offensive.

Word that American reinforcements are moving to the support of the Allies in Picardy has revived argument in Germany over the efficacy of the submarine and draws from Captain Persius, military critic of the Berliner Tageblatt, the comment that after being persuaded to underestimate the American effort, every effort will be made to sell a bond to every man working here.


