

Rotary Club Will See Adding Machine History In Moving Pictures

Mr. Stonehatchet, the world's first banker, will post his accounts on the side of a cliff; Mr. A. B. Origine will

figure on his fingers and toes; a Chinaman will figure on the abacus; the old-fashioned quill pen book-keeper will hunt for errors by candle light; and the lucky office man of to-day will figure and keep books by machinery before Harrisburg Rotarians at the weekly luncheon at the Y. M. C. A. Monday noon.

"The Machine That Thinks" is the title of the film that takes the audience through the evolution of accounting from the stone age to the present time. The picture is said to be one of the most interesting commercial films yet produced, combining animated humorous and mechanical drawings with straight photography. The mystery of the adding machine, the machine that

freed the human mind from the burden of figure drudgery, is revealed for the first time. Since adding machines are now almost as widely used as typewriters, the interest in this picture among businessmen is general. The Rotary Club is indebted to Dr. Dowdell, manager of the Harrisburg agency of the Burroughs

Adding Machine Company, for the exhibition of the film. A. H. Loucks, district advertising manager of the company, will show the picture. William Seward Burroughs, inventor of the first adding and listing machine, was born in Rochester, N. Y., in 1838. As a young man he wrestled with mental additions in a bank in Auburn, N. Y., until his in-

ventive genius conceived an adding machine that would work. He went to St. Louis, Mo., where in the little machine shop of Joseph Boyer, now president of the Burroughs Adding Machine Company, he drew the plans and made the parts of the first practical adding machine. The mechanical skill of Burroughs was so great that to-day the shaft centers in the

modern machine are the same to a thousandth of an inch as they were in the first model. Of course, the operating principle has not changed. In 1886 the American Arithmometer Company was organized and the manufacture of Burroughs machines began in earnest. In 1904 the plant moved to Detroit and the name was changed to the Burroughs Adding

Machine Company, in honor of the inventor. When Mr. Burroughs first thought of the adding machine, he thought of banks as the only prospective buyers. Last year the Burroughs Company manufactured and marketed to all lines of business 63,000 machines; this year the output will be 50 per cent. greater.
