MILLION TONS OF U. S. SHIPS READY FOR HUN

150 Steel Vessels on May 11 to Help Defeat Germany on Sea

Washington, May 14.—The first million tons of ships completed and delivered to the United States government under the direction of the Shipping Board have been put on the high seas to help defeat Germany. A total of 159 vessels of 1,108,621 tons was completed up to May 11, according to statistics compiled by experts of the Shipping Board. Since January 1 more than half of the total tonnage, 667,896, has been delivered, and the monthly totals have shown a steady increase.
