I finally got closer to the last plane. At a distance of 100 yards I opened fire with incendiary bullets and the German machine almost immediately burst into flames and fell.

"I continued straight on my course," he went on, "and within two minutes had the other enemy machine before me. He started a quick dive, but I am certain that some of the bullets went home, One of the wings of the machine crumpled up at the same moment. As I circled about I saw one machine other, smoking in its downward plunge, crash to the earth. That is all there is to it. It was a cinch."
