

Exiles and Interned Find Haven in Holland

London, May 31.—Discussing the status of foreigners in Holland, Cord van der Linden, Dutch Minister of the Interior, said that there are at present in Holland 100,000 Belgian exiles, 3,125 English, 1,607 German soldiers, 679 escaped prisoners and 1,543 Russians and Poles.

The interned war prisoners and fugitives receive the same treatment, he said, as the Dutch people. He declared that the various governments have agreed to supply provisions for their subjects, but that Belgium could not be asked to supply its refugees at present. He denounced those of the Dutch people who grumble against the hospitality of Holland toward all strangers.
