

Threat to Starve Austria Unless She Yields

Venice.—Il Secolo, the best informed newspaper in Northern Italy upon internal affairs of the Dual Monarchy of Austria-Hungary, draws a vivid picture of the distress suffered by the population, especially the poorer classes, a condition, it argues, which has been brought about by the Berlin government with the malicious intent and forethought of compelling Emperor Karl to place himself and his empire absolutely into the clutches of Germany.

There can be no doubt that the paper is well informed. The question is only how far Austria, outside of military solidarity, has permitted the Wilhelmstrasse crowd to interfere in her domestic affairs and to what extent the Balhausplatz offices are being ruled by and from Berlin. Fact is, whether Il Secolo knows it or not, Germany has not permitted Austria-Hungary to participate in the distribution of the millions of bushels of corn and wheat or rye, which the enslavement of Rumania has thrown into the hands of the Teuton conqueror, and which was done under the plea that Hungary herself was well enough provided because of the vast wheat and grain sections of her cis-Leithanian territory.

There may have been some truth in that assertion, for Hungary unquestionably is the second richest wheat, rye and corn producing country in Europe, the Dobruja, also a former possession of Hungary, in proportion to its small size, being the first; that is, the first not counting the vast Russian steppes that begin in Bessarabia, on the shores of the Black Sea, and stretch all the way across Europe to the foothills of the Caucasus and the Caspian Sea and Persia. There millions upon millions of bushels of the finest wheat are grown in an unbroken prairie of several thousand miles, which suffices to keep Russia's millions on the shores of the Euxine well stocked with plenty for all of Russia, as well as that portion of Siberia, where hardly anything can be raised owing to the close proximity of the Arctic and its ever-frozen seas.

Like the anguish of Tantalus of old, who was condemned to see water, plenty of water, forever trickling right up to his mouth, but receding as soon as he tried to snatch a single drop, the Kaiser holds this cup of plenty ever before the eyes of his dear friend Karl, only to snatch it from the starving masses of Austria such a time as the poor, enchained young ruler of Austria comes back into the fold, now that the old treaty is soon to expire.
