Iron Men From Pennsylvania Chased Huns Like Rabbits, Says Returned Harrisburg Officer; Expects Four Regiments to Be Decorated

The entire audience at the Orpheum Theater during the intermission of the war picture being shown there rose to its feet and gave Lieutenant James T. Long, formerly of Company D, Eighth Infantry...

retreating Germans to the last breath and said he knew his time was near. The army had no meat except the artillery horses killed by French shells...

"One of the American regiments found three women in uniform in one of the captured French trenches. Whether they were fighting or not I do not know...

"The Americans stand up well under hardships," said Lieutenant Long. "At one stretch we went 72 hours without food and were fighting most of the time."

"The whole four regiments of the division that we were under and the French mean to decorate all of them. Where for lack of man power the Thirty-second Division failed to take the Vesle river, our division was thrown in and we not only crossed it, but went some hundred yards beyond, where we entrenched...

"When the Marines had gone through Chateau Thierry we were ordered in to take up the drive against the Germans and up to the time I left we had driven them back for thirty-five miles, taking immense numbers of prisoners...

"The men at the machine guns kept up their fire from the nests prepared from them in advance and after they had shot as many Americans as they could, attempted to surrender...

"We found them in depressions and in trees and not a few Huns were brought down like squirrels from the topmost branches. One German officer of artillery I found near his gun. He was dead and his body was still warm...

"The market is very firm at the opening of today's market. New York is showing moderate reactionary tendencies before the start of the first half hour as a result of bearish aggressions. Rails were again the leading sustaining influence...
