

TROLLEY LINE WAS NEGLECTED

Charges of Gross Mismanagement Made at Hearing in Railway Receiver Case

Carlisle, Pa., Sept. 7.—Charges of gross mismanagement were made at the second hearing in the applications of representatives and bondholders of the Cumberland Railway Company for the appointment of a receiver for the property.

It was also contended by the complainants that the company owes between \$10,000 and \$20,000 in back taxes to the state. Testimony was taken to show that S. M. Kitzmiller prepared the statements for the Auditor General's office and that two of the officers, according to Plough, swore to them with little investigation.

It was also brought out that the company has sold \$17,000 in machinery since the first hearing a few weeks ago. President Kitzmiller, Mr. Plough stated, prepared all of the financial statements, but he did not investigate them, although treasurer, two men only are employed for maintenance work on the eighteen miles of track, according to Plough.

Witnesses said that the property is rapidly deteriorating. D. B. Moist, engineer of the Harrisburg Railway Company testified that the lines and poles of the Newville line have depreciated 50 per cent. and that on a stretch of the Mount Holly section ties no longer have any holding power.

The hearing was adjourned to include only the Cumberland Railway Company, the traction holding concern.
