

Republicans Stand For Dictated Peace

Washington, Sept. 10.—Representative S. D. Fess, of Ohio, emphasized his acceptance of the chairmanship of the Republican National Congressional Committee by issuing a

formal address to the Republicans of the country in which he said that the chief business of the country was to win the war. "The chief business to-day is to win the war," he said. "It is the all-important work before us, and will continue to be so until the job is finished. We have authorized the employ-

ment of our maximum resources, both of man and money power, for this purpose. The task demands the best in plan, organization and execution. It calls for the highest degree of efficiency in administration. It forbids halting, hesitation from whatever reason, whether fear of responsibility or uncertainty of results. While it requires unlimited expendi-

ture of money which Congress has fully authorized, it also calls for rigid business policy to insure against unprofitable waste of funds. "Republicans from the very outset emphasized the danger of a policy of hesitation and uncertainty; the Democrats pursued the policy of watchful waiting. While Republicans urged a state of preparation, the

Democrats counseled against nervousness and assured the country that there is such a thing as a people too proud to fight. While Republicans in and out of Congress demanded the protection of our national honor, the Democrats asked support because they had kept the country out of war. This policy was

urged after the tragedies of the German submarines. "As chairman of the National Republican Congressional Committee, I shall endeavor to secure Republican control of the next Congress as the most important single factor now before us, that we may vigorously prosecute the war, give assurance of a conclusive peace, and insure a
