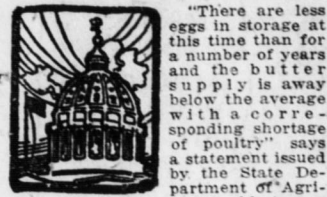


SMALL AMOUNT OF STORED FOOD
