The per capita sale of War Saving Stamps in Dauphin county has been \$6.13, according to the report received yesterday by Postmaster Frank C. Sites, who is in charge of the War Savings Stamp sales in the county. The county is far behind its quota, as the per capita sale at this time should be about \$15. Dauphin county stands tenth on the list of counties in Pennsylvania which have more than 100,000 pop-ulation. There are only eleven such counties. Dauphin county sales to date have been \$95,973.
