Washington, Nov. 8.—Latest reports to-day on the few districts still remaining doubtful in last Tuesday's elections indicate Republican control of the next Senate by a bare majority, with no change in the substantial Republican majority already assured in the House.

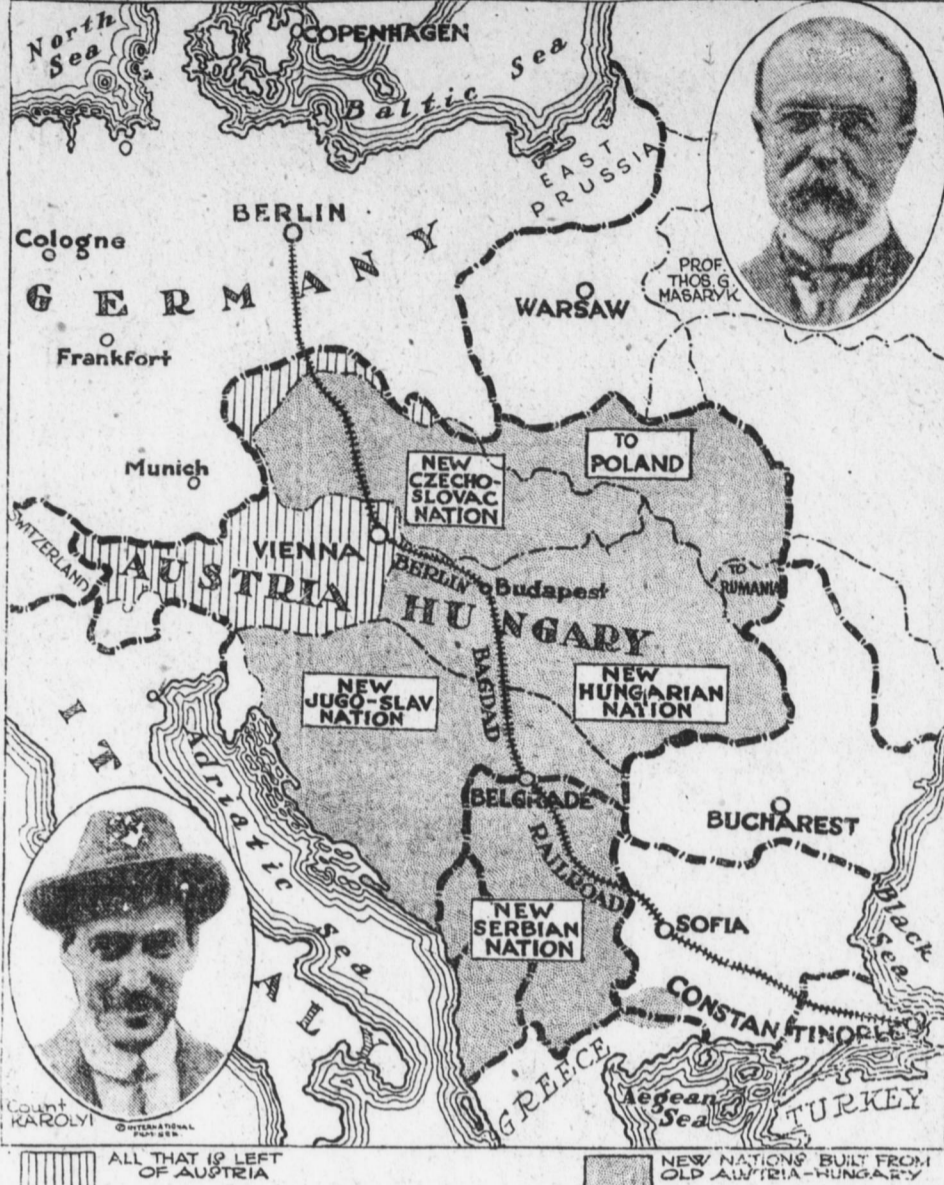

NEW NATIONS INTO WHICH AUSTRIA-HUNGARY WILL BE SPLIT UP



This map indicates the principal changes that will result from the dismembering of Austria-Hungary. Some of them had taken place even before Austria accepted the Entente Allies' drastic armistice conditions, following the lines laid down in President Wilson's fourteen principles. There will be minor changes in the alignment of nationalities and races, but the general trend of national reorganization is shown here.

Thomas G. Masaryk, professor of the Bohemian Political Committee abroad and president of the congress of races subordinate to Germany and Austria, has played an important part in preparing subjects of the German and Austrian rulers for re-education. At a meeting in independence Hall, Philadelphia, the congress made a statement of the aspirations of the various races.

Count Karolyi, whose party set up a republic while in control of the situation, has resigned as head of the Hungarian National Council, according to recent reports. He considered that the holding of that position was incompatible with being Premier, but he has provisionally taken the portfolio of foreign affairs and will have a part in coming changes in Hungary.

Bowles Supporter of Transport Type

Philadelphia.—Warning against permitting the merchant marine of the United States to become a "hob-tail" affair, by curtailing the production of transport ships, is voiced by Rear Admiral Francis T. Bowles, assistant general manager of the Emergency Fleet Corporation.

"I believe that the interests of the United States will be served best," said the admiral, "by the completion of all steel vessels fit for overseas trade, especially by the completion of all transports. Our merchant marine never will be able to maintain itself, nor be the complement of the navy that it ought to be, without providing ships of the transport class, which may be used in time of peace as moderate-speed mail steamers.

"There are seventy transport ships of about 8,000 tons deadweight on the contract held by the American International Shipbuilding Corporation, to be built at Hog Island for the Emergency Fleet Corporation. There is every indication that these ships will be completed.

Transport Type in Demand
While the majority of the ships already built by the Fleet Corporation have been cargo carriers, in order to meet the immediate emergency of vital war needs, there is a big field for the transport type of vessel for the commercial demands of the nation when peace becomes an accomplished fact. The transport design embraces both cargo and passenger service.

MILLIONS HOAXED BY WILD TALE OF WORLD WAR'S END

Each Hour Adds Proof to Falsity of United Press Cablegram

New York, Nov. 8.—Millions of Americans realized to-day that they had been hoaxed into celebrating the end of the war by publication of the United Press dispatches declaring the armistice signed and fighting ended.

Twenty-four hours have passed since the country was thrown into a delirium by these reports which declare the armistice had been signed at 11 o'clock yesterday morning and that fighting had ceased at 2 o'clock yesterday afternoon.

Each hour brings added official evidence that the reports were false and that the American people were fooled. The German delegates' communications from France to the State Department at Washington denounced the reports as untrue, but the British war offices show the fighting still going on.

Tech High Seniors May Enter Training Camps

The demand for army and navy officers is urgent; many students in the Pennsylvania State College are being drawn off to officers training camps. The college is empowered by the War Department to recruit its Students' Army Training Corps of 1,600 men. This will be done in part by offering a special term beginning Monday, November 11, for men physically fit, who were registered for military service on September 13.

Each candidate must be certified by his High school as having completed at least fourteen units in a four-year High school course or its equivalent. After admission to college, a student is sworn into the army or navy, receives board, lodging, uniform and pay from the government and pursues some regular college course, with extra military drill, until he is called to an officers training camp.
