reconstruction." While no specific "unscrupulous" measures were indicated that the Congress shall assert its dorse it was understood that individual members of the conference will offer a series of bills at an early date to abolish the war powers of the administration.

Abuse War Powers

After the conference had adjourned Senator Sherman, of Illinois, gave out an interview in which he characterized the taking over of the marine cables five days after the virtual end of the war as "an arrogant abuse of war powers."

Publicity For Wilson

Senator Watson, of Indiana, voiced vigorous protest in the conference against the taking over of the cables. He expects to make a speech elaborating his views in the Senate on Thursday.

West Fairview Soldier Is Missing in Action

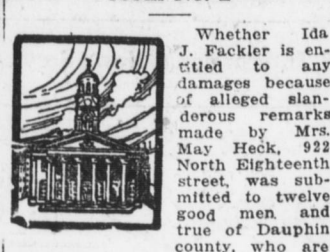

SLANDER SUIT HEARD BY JURY

Action Brought Against May Heck Aired in Courtroom No. 2



Whether Ida J. Fackler is entitled to any damages because of alleged slanderous remarks made by Mrs. May Heck, 922 North Eighteenth street, was submitted to twelve good men and true of Dauphin county, who are expected to return a verdict late today.

Mrs. Heck, it is charged in the action, accused the other woman of theft.
